Originally a secondary physics teacher, as Deputy Principal of Richardson Primary School he was responsible for leading the team of teachers who pioneered the effective use of IWBs. In 2003 the school received an Award of Excellence in Education from the Australian College of Educators and in 2005 they received an Australian National Award for Quality Schooling – Outstanding School Improvement. Peter has published articles in a number of professional journals and delivered conference presentations and professional development workshops in Nth America, Europe, Asia and extensively throughout Australia.

#### **Inspired Teaching with an IWB – What Does it Look Like?**

In some ways Interactive Whiteboards can be considered as amplifiers of teaching; that is to say that they can not only make good teaching inspired, but they can also make mediocre teaching dismal. During this presentation teachers will be walked through the pedagogy that underpins the successful use of an IWB within the classroom. There will be examples of how to effectively use an IWB to promote high levels of intellectual quality, teach metacognition to students, increase the relevance of the curriculum, create a supportive learning focused environment, assist with behaviour management and promote relationships within the classroom.

#### **The Place Of Most Potential**

One of the realities of the ever-changing world of technology is that 90% of what will be considered good teaching with technology in 5 years time has not been 'invented' yet. As schools and teachers how do we deal with this? How can we plan to ensure that we can take this rapid change 'in our stride'? How can schools and classrooms become the 'place of most potential' for student learning? How can an IWB assist with this? This presentation will offer a solution to the problem of managing the fast pace of technological change in schools and the classroom.
